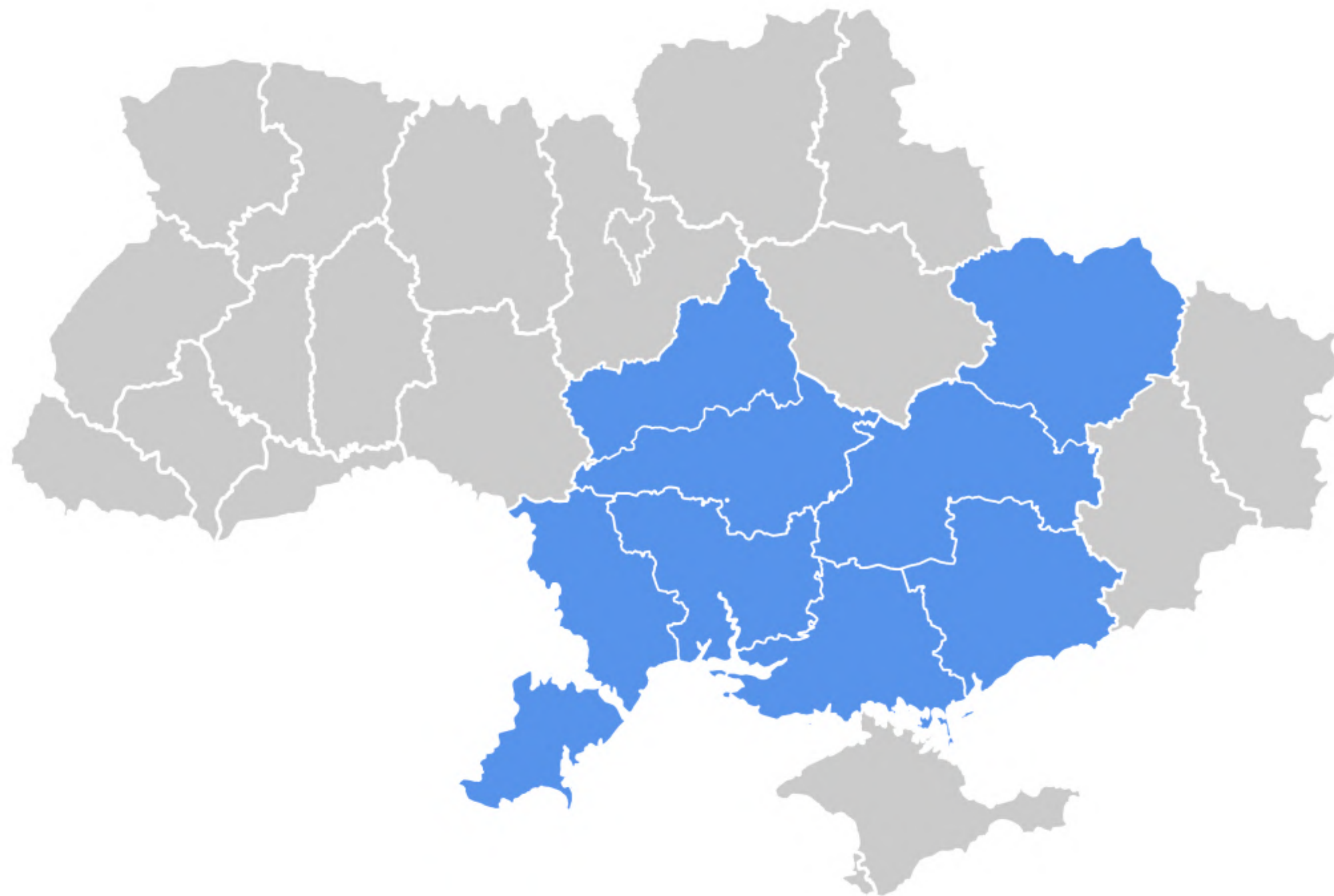

THE RISK OF STATELESSNESS

- we help to **gather and restore the required documents** to establish belonging to the citizenship of Ukraine or to determine **the status of a stateless person and receipt of residence permit;**

- we help to **gather the required documents** for **identification of a person;**

- we help **to restore records and birth certificates,** or we help **to register the birth,** if the corresponding certificate has never been obtained;

- we **accompany** when applying **to public authorities,** and **provide assistance** to a lawyer when applying **to the court.**

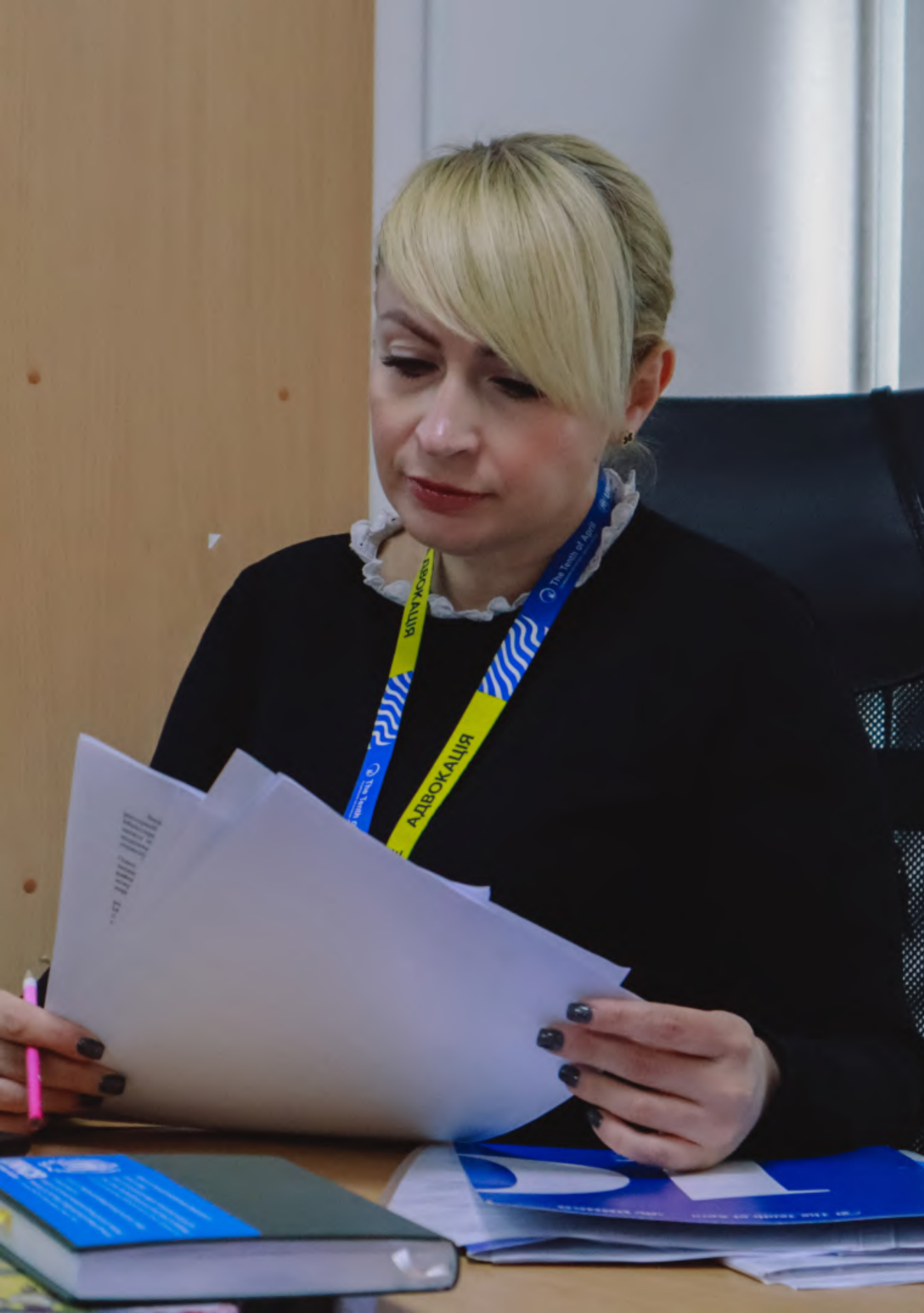

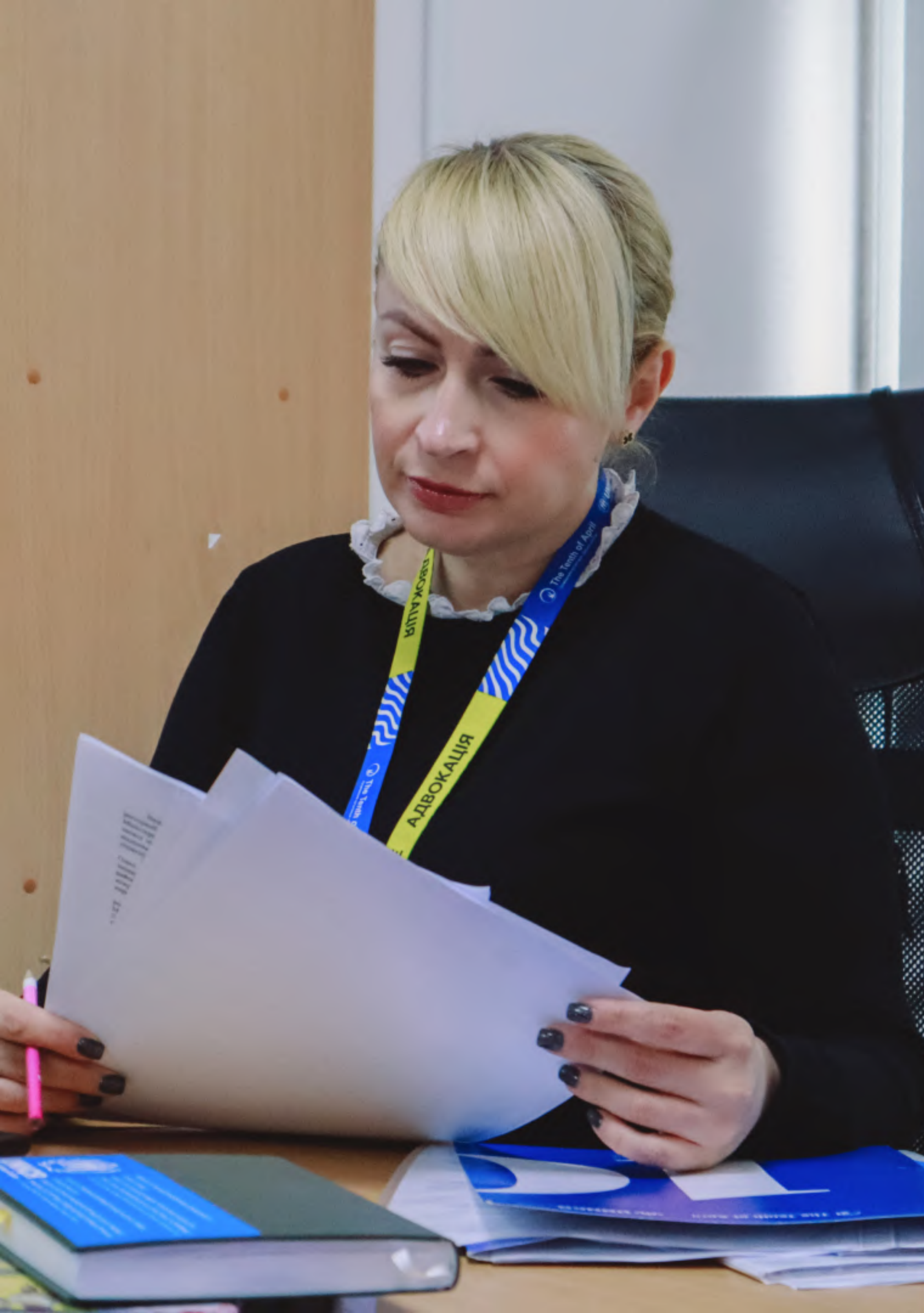

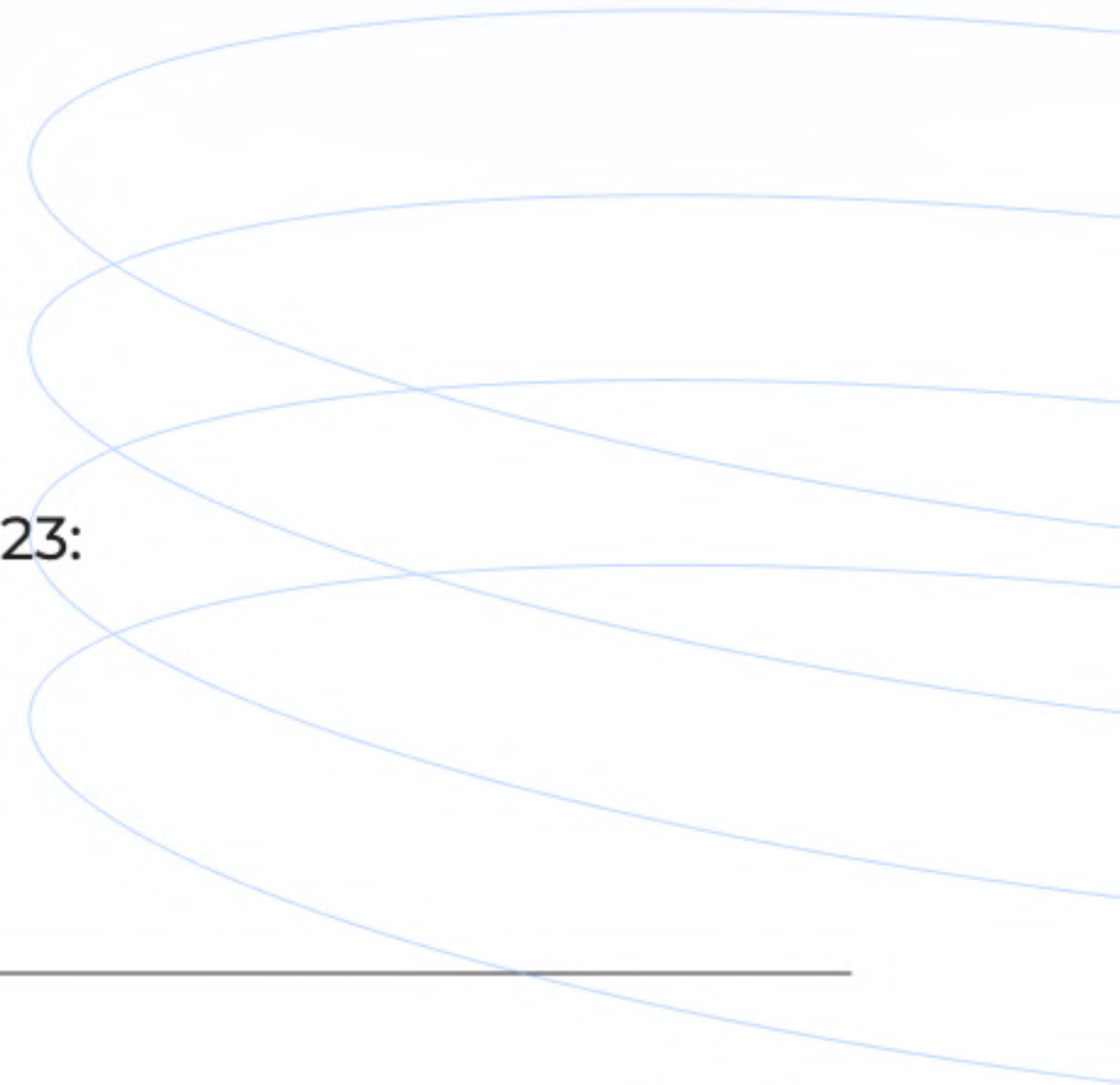

THE FOLLOWING GROUPS OF BENEFICIARIES ARE INVOLVED IN THE PROJECT

Internally displaced persons transiting through the Mykolaiv transport hub (to Kherson and Kherson region, populated areas of Mykolaiv region), arriving in Mykolaiv after a long stay in other regions of Ukraine or abroad, leaving for other regions of Ukraine due to the deterioration of the security situation or destruction of housing

Local residents of the city of Mykolaiv and the Mykolaiv region who belong to vulnerable groups of the population or **have suffered from the war** due to temporary occupation or proximity to areas of hostilities

Social workers, volunteers, lawyers, psychologists who work with vulnerable population groups **in conditions of long-term stress** in the city of Mykolaiv and the Mykolaiv region

Children and adolescents who are **internally displaced persons** and live in compact housing together with their parents, or live in remote settlements where there is no proper access to psychosocial services





The total number of covered beneficiaries during May was

175 UNIQUE PEOPLE

(including 125 people - women (71%) and 50 people - men (29%))



62 UNIQUE BENEFICIARIES

were provided psychological first assistance in the transport hub of Mykolaiv and upon departure to the district centers of the Mykolaiv region (Bashtanka)

individual consultations were provided. (7 were unique beneficiaries). According to the results of consultations, 2 beneficiaries **were referred to other medical specialists** (neurologist, psychotherapist, family doctor)

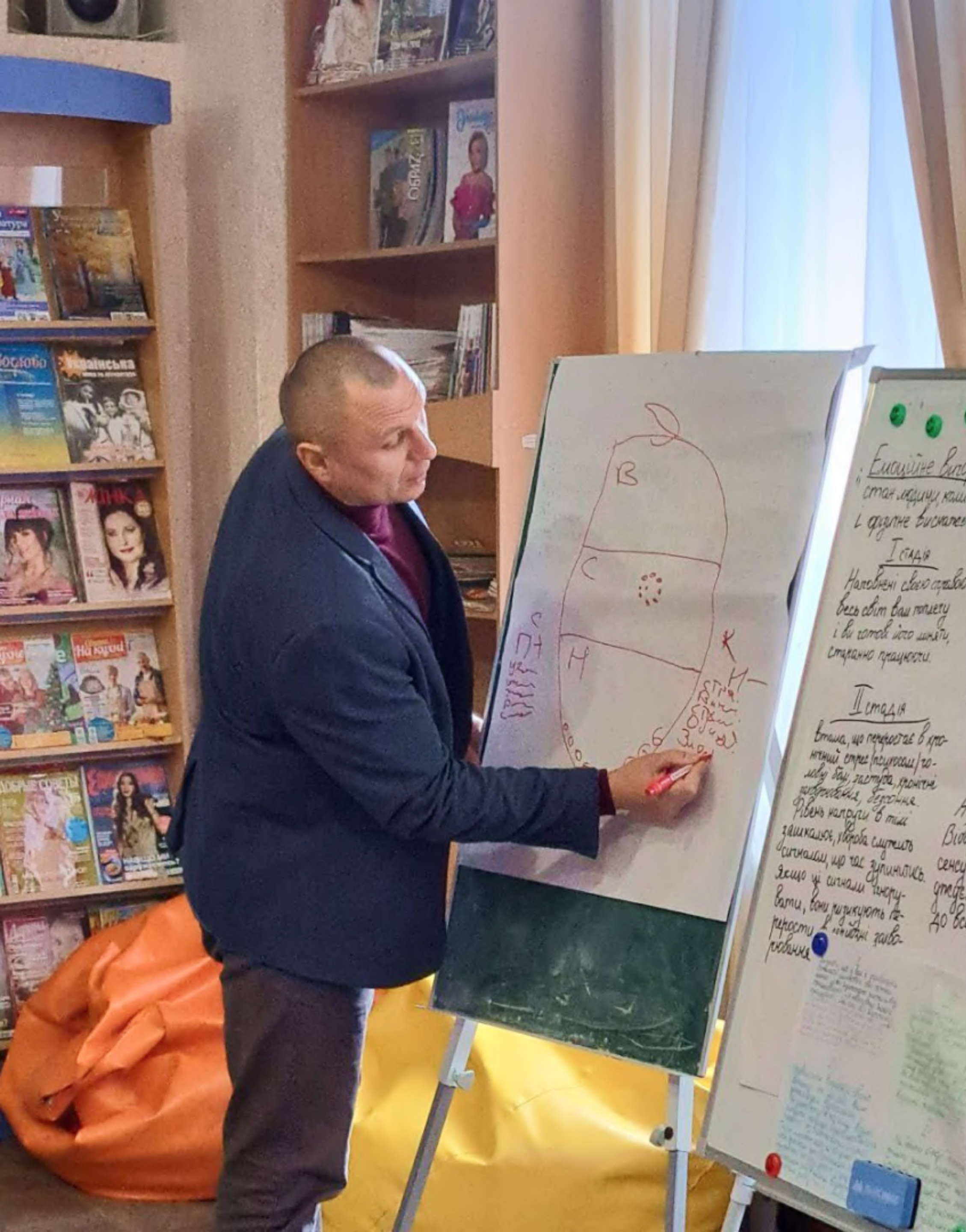

THE AIM

is to rehabilitate water supply facilities in war-affected areas to ensure stable access to clean drinking water for the rural population, thereby improving their livelihoods and facilitating the return of displaced persons from the end of conflict to the recovery period

THE AIM

to promote resilience and build capacity for local response mechanisms, be it formal national non-governmental organizations (NGOs), civil society.

Increasing capacity for:

1. Protection mainstreaming and general humanitarian principles,
2. SGBV case management, Child Protection case management,
3. Non-conflict communication, mediation and conflicts resolution,
4. Safeguarding

EMERGENCY WASH RESPONSE TO SUPPORT
CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES, INCLUDING:
IDPS AFFECTED BY THE CONFLICT AND HOSTILITIES
IN MYKOLAIV, ODESA AND KHERSON REGIONS

THE AIM

to improve the living conditions of citizens in the field of water supply by

- assessing and inspecting water supply systems and other water, sanitation and hygiene rehabilitation needs in settlements/communities/towns/villages
- drilling and installation of 6 wells and installation of a reverse osmosis system for institutions;
- purchase of materials and equipment for the operation of water supply networks, pumping stations and water treatment facilities;





- rehabilitation of more than 30 water supply facilities in schools and healthcare facilities;
- identifying the needs and supplying chemicals for water treatment to support water utilities;
- providing emergency water supply via vehicles, etc.



- repair and rehabilitation of more than 30 water supply networks, including the purchase of equipment (pumps, solar systems, pipes, fittings, valves, etc.) using sustainable solutions and including capacity building;
- supply of chemicals for water treatment to support water utilities outside the main city (based on needs assessment);
- rehabilitation of more than 30 water supply facilities in schools and healthcare facilities;
- identifying the needs and supplying chemicals for water treatment to support water utilities;
- providing emergency water supply via vehicles, etc.

TTA FUTURE PLANS

Implement best practices in different areas in the current area of responsibilities, as well as reach new areas and regions;

Provide multi-purpose cash assistance to most beneficiaries who require it to reach long-term solutions

Empower communities of beneficiaries to ensure they help their members and other population

Reach PoCs with high-quality services in most of the rural areas, creating points of access to assistance in smaller towns/villages and through mobile Multi-Functional Teams

Provide targeted assistance (in cash and non-cash forms) to people with specific needs (e.g., for healthcare, evacuation, accommodation, education)

Develop and implement the livelihood and self-reliance program, supporting employment, self-employment, and the start of the small business for affected people

Create possibilities for the peaceful coexistence of newly arrived IDPs, refugees, asylum seekers, and local host communities

Use the case-management-based approach to the provision of different types of assistance

Promote eco-friendly and environment-oriented approaches in activities and environment protection projects
